



Restricted courses	 Courses offered by the ANU Medical School are not available. Art studio and design courses are limited. Law courses are only available to students who are enrolled in a law degree at their home institution. All students must meet the pre-requisite requirements for the courses they wish to take.
Full course load	24 ANU units per semester (typically 4 courses at 6 units each)
Minimum course load	18 ANU units per semester (with approval from home institution and ANU)

Health insurance requirements	Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is a compulsory requirement for obtaining an Australian student visa. In 2020, the cost for one semester (6 months coverage) was AU\$330 and the cost for two semesters (15 months coverage) was AU\$771. VISA REQUIREMENTS

Students must hold a current visa which entitles them to study for the duration of their program. Typically this is a subclass 500 student visa. Students should apply for a student visa as soon as they receive their electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE). All visas are subject to conditions and students must ensure they comply with the conditions of their visa at all times.
