YOUR TICKET TO MAKE IT HAPPEN

If your home institution (the institution you are completing your degree at) has an exchange agreement with ANU then you may be able to secure an exchange place for a semester or year abroad. Through this agreement you are not required to pay any course fees to ANU!



Eligibility

To be eligible to come to ANU as an exchange student you need to meet both the academic and English language requirements.



must have completed at least one year (full time or equivalent) at your home institution.



A minimum GPA of an equivalent to 4 out of 7 - or as per your institutions specific agreement

English language requirements:
