The HSG at a glance

- University of St.Gallen (HSG) School of Management, Economics, Law, Social Sciences, International Affairs and Computer Science
- Founded in 1898 as one of the first Business Universities in Europe
- Public university: Canton of St.Gallen
- Degrees: B.A. HSG, M.A. HSG, Ph.D. HSG, full- and part-time MBAs (Computer Science; BSc, MSc, Ph.D.)
- Student body: More than 9,000 students, 34% female students
- Faculty: 102 professors, 80 assistant professors, 30 permanent lecturers and 551 lecturers
- Institutes: 42 institutes and centers
- Top-ranked in the Financial Times Rankings
- Accreditations: EQUIS, AACSB and AMBA




Where is St.Gallen located?

- 80,000 inhabitants
- German-speaking part of Switzerland
- Close to Swiss Alps and Lake Constance
- Close to numerous ski resorts
- City founded in 610 AD
- Cultural and educational history since 900 AD
- In the past: textiles and embroideries
- Today: trade, services, and education
- Only 1 hour's journey to the Zurich International Airport



Facts and impressions of Switzerland



- Population of 8.5 million (24.3% foreign nationals)
- Surface area of 41,285 square kilometres
- 4 national languages: German, French, Italian, Romansh
- Most competitive economy in the world
- Switzerland is situated in the heart of Europe
- One of the highest annual per capita GDPs worldwide
- Low unemployment rate: 3.2% (2018)
- Zurich scores second highest worldwide for quality of living
