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Academics

Our program allows you to enroll directly in classes at the Universidad de San Andrés. Most of all of the courses are taught in Spanish by full-time faculty.

Language Requirements: At least **two years of college level Spanish or a B2 level** in the Common European Framework of Languages. In addition, many courses have some reading materials in English. Students should be proficient in **English (B2 level)**.

Grading System

San Andres doesn't use a credit system. Students should estimate equivalencies using class contact hours and comparing with the number of credits provided at his or her institution per contact hour. Equivalencies should always be checked with academic advisors prior to exchange participation.

Grading system: System 10 point scale, 4 is a pass.

Pass/Fail: International students on exchange at UdeSA can select if they want a Pass /Fail grade instead of a numeric grade when registering for course.

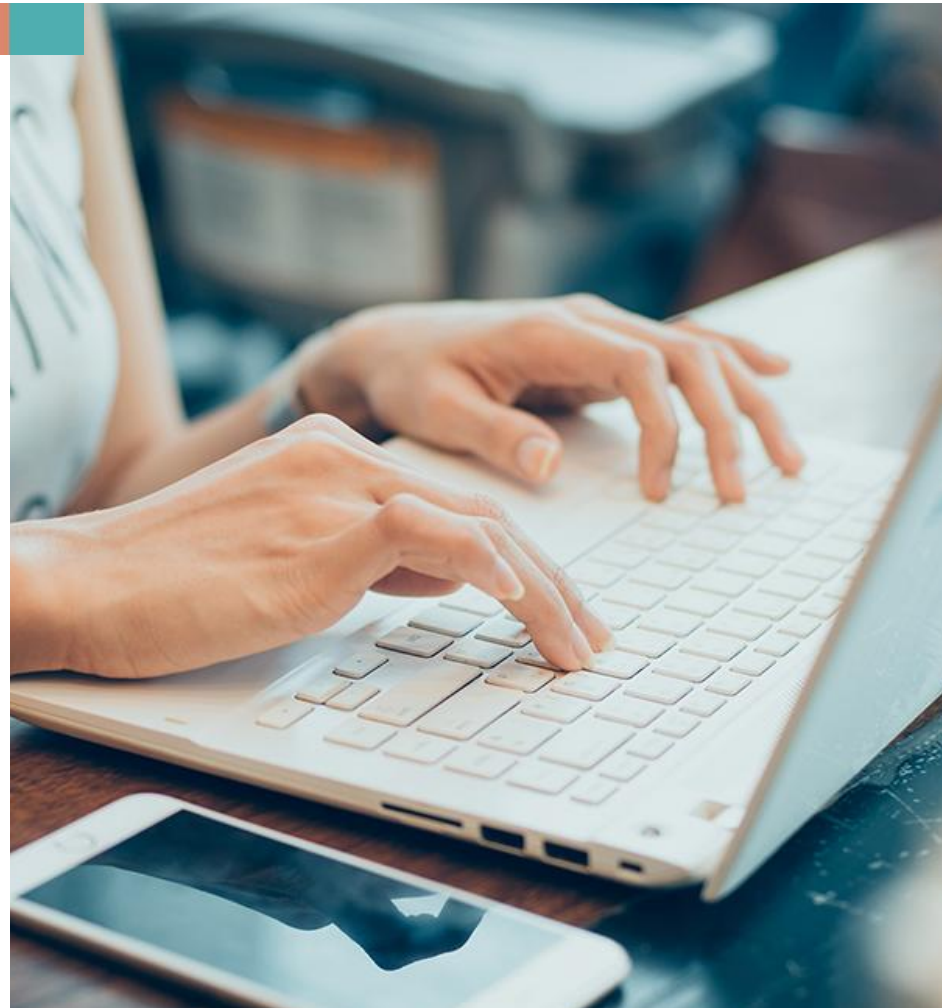
Courses at UdeSA

Course Catalog

<https://www.udesa.edu.ar/catalogo-de-materias>. The catalog of courses includes a brief description, classroom contact hours, and a link to a recent syllabus as well as the semester in which the course is offered and year in degree when students take the course.

Course Load Undergraduate: Recommended 3 or 4 courses per semester. Min 2 courses - Max 4 courses. Five courses may be taken only with written permission from Academic Director of International Programs. Courses require between 4 and 6 hrs. of class time per course per week (including lectures and tutorials).

Course Load Graduate: The normal workload for a local graduate student at UdeSA is 3 courses per semester and 1 or 2 seminars.




Spanish Courses during semester

Two levels of Advanced Spanish language courses are offered as part of the regular curriculum during the semester.

H330: Español avanzado: uso y gramática
